Local Officer Saves a life

It's not something officers normally experience... A local response officer was deployed to a property to perform a concern for safety check. Upon arrival, through a door's window, the officer could see a person in immediate risk of death. With officer's calm methodical skills and MOE (Method of entry) training, a forced entry was executed. The officer revived and stabilised the patient until ambulance arrived. The officer has been awarded an area commanders commendation.

ASB

In Dec 2021 x1 UBWL (Unacceptable behaviour warning letters) were issued to offenders. For Jan 2022 this number has fallen zero due to the collaboration between local NPT and partners cracking down on ASB to improve people's lives.

A short write up in the local news provides more details.

Criminal Damage

22:57hrs 27/01/2022, Incident 498. Report taken of a male smashing up Lloyds ATM, High Street, Horncastle. These actions caught by the council CCTV network. Response police arrived on scene within minutes, arresting the male, who's been charged with criminal damage.

This does not include other moving traffic offences such as contravening roads signs/lane markings, Fatal4 offences.

FATAL4

Officers continue to identify, target and deal with drivers who make our roads unsafe by committing speeding, seatbelt, drink/drug driving and mobile phone offences.

NPT would like to thank an Armed Response Unit, who kindly, in a lull from their busy schedule, helped with Fatal4 enforcement. In this brief time, they issued x6 Traffic Offence Reports at the A153, West Ashby.

notice of intended prosecution (NIP). All that was asked, was to supply details of the driver at time of offence,

who were, as at it transpires, one of the same. Despite speaking to the issuing officer and second written reminder, the driver failed to comply. Courts issued x6 endorseable points and several £100s in fines. If the driver did comply, the driver may have just received a driver awareness course.

E-Scooter

May I remind everyone, in Lincolnshire, it is illegal to ride an e-scooter on public land, roads, footpaths, carparks or other public open spaces, unless that is, regardless of rider's age, the rider has valid road use insurance and UK driving licence with category 'q'. If stopped, the scooter will be seized and crushed with rider reported for the related offences.

Wildlife Crime (Operation Galileo)

To prevent hare coursing, during January 2022, dispersal notices have been put in place by senior officers. For the period this period, x36 wildlife incidents were recorded, x12 involved hare coursing. As part of Op Galileo, police have a specialist team to

intercept and deal with offences. Again, a number of people have been reported, vehicles and dogs seized. Any unclaimed vehicles will be crushed and dogs rehomed.
